Directions to Sydney Dance Company Studios

By Foot

From Circular Quay or Wynyard Station, walk up George Street through The Rocks until you get to a T-intersection. Turn left into Lower Fort street, cross the street, and just past the pedestrian crossing, you'll see a pathway [opposite the Harbourview Hotel]. Go down the path and you'll see The Wharf in front of you. Go down the stairs, turn right, and wind your way onto Hickson Road and walk to The Wharf. The walk from Circular Quay takes approx. 10–15 minutes.

By Bus

The 430, 431 and 433 services run from QVB/Town Hall to Walsh Bay via Wynyard and Circular Quay. Buses run every 20 minutes between 7am and 11pm weekdays (weekend schedule slightly reduced), and stops outside The Wharf.

By Car

There is meter parking on Hickson Road at the front of The Wharf. From George St, turn right into Hickson Road [last right hand turn before the end of George St] and follow the road round, under the bridge.

Directions to University of NSW

By Car from the CBD

Head up Oxford Street, turn right onto Flinders St, then continue to Anzac Parade and then UNSW.

By Bus

Routes **390** , **391** , **392** , **394** , **396** - **399** and **L94** (express) depart from Circular Quay, and travel along Elizabeth Street, Liverpool St, Oxford St, Flinders St and Anzac Parade to UNSW, stopping at the main entrance.

Routes **393** and **395** depart from Railway Square (Central Railway Station), travel along Eddy Avenue, Elizabeth Street, Cleveland St and Anzac Parade to UNSW, stopping at the main entrance.

Route **400** travels between Rockdale, Airport and Bondi. The University is mid-route.

Route **370** travels between Leichhardt, Glebe, Newtown and Coogee, also stopping at UNSW.

Other minor routes, including **301** - **304** and **357** also service UNSW.

Parking at UNSW

There are two major parking stations:

Barker Street Carpark - Entry via Gate 14, Barker Street.

Botany Street Carpark - Enter via Gate 11, Botany Street.

Parking on campus is available at minimum charge on weekdays. Short-term metered parking is available in both parking stations and at various locations around campus.

Parking is free on weekends. Half and full day "pay and display" ticket machines are available on the top 2 levels of both Barker and Botany Street parking stations. Change machines are not available.

Single-day parking permits are available for advance purchase through the Venues & Events office. Permits enable guests to park in "UNSW Permit Holders Only" parking areas in the two parking stations. Guests must scratch off the relevant day/date/month on the permit and display it clearly on the vehicle's dashboard.

Availability of parking spaces is not guaranteed on weekdays.
